	☐ Patient forms that your physicians office gave you to fill out (these include patient
	history and anesthesia questionnaire)
	☐ Any crutches, braces, or other devices needed after surgery
	☐ Documents requiring your doctor's signature
✓	For overnight stay

	□ Nightgown/Pajamas
	□ Robe
	☐ Comfortable clothing (sweatpants, loose shirts)
	□ Slippers
	□ Shoes
	Toiletries:
	☐ Toothbrush/Toothpaste
	□ Razor
	□ Soap/Shampoo
	☐ Feminine Hygiene Products

✓	Preparation
	☐ Do not eat or drink anything after midnight, not even water
	☐ Follow your physicians instructions for taking prescriptions, insulin and over-the-
	counter medications for the day of surgery
	Follow the "night before surgery" instructions that you will be given at your pre-
	admission appointment these include
	Do not smoke, chew gum, or use mints after midnight
	Remove colored nail polish on fingers and toes
	☐ Please leave all valuables at home or give to someone to hold (jewelry, phones, electronic devices, wallets, purses)

	Plan ahead to have a responsible adult drive you home once you are discharged
